Khor Wakow Project serves people of all ages. KWP touched the lives of 6,205 students this year alone.

- KWP serves 2,497 preschool students (1,103 girls and 1,397 boys).
- KWP serves 3,455 First through eighth grade students, (1,438 girls and 2,017 boys)
- KWP serves 253 adults (167 women and 86 men)

South Sudanese celebrated a Final Peace Agreement in Juba on Wednesday, October 31st, 2018. The Final Peace celebration was attended by the East African presidents and guests from around the world. The opposition's spokeperson and adviser who had been sentenced to death two years ago by the South Sudanese court were released as part of the peace deal. This led the "opposition leader" to attend the Final Peace celebration in Juba. The implementation of an actual peace process is yet to begin.

We ask you to continue to pray for South Sudanese to silence their guns and to embrace peace!! God bless you,
